ANDRONICO'S sells eggs from caged hens, each confined in a space as **SMALL** as this piece of paper— **A MEAGER 67 SQUARE INCHES.**

ANDRONICO'S touts itself for caring about animal welfare, yet it sells eggs from hens confined in barren, wire “battery cages” so small the birds can’t even spread their wings—let alone engage in nearly any other important natural behaviors, such as nesting, foraging, or even walking. These cages are so tiny that the hens can barely move.

Understanding the cruelty of battery cages and wanting to reduce the suffering of egg-laying hens, California retailers Whole Foods Market, Wild Oats Marketplaces, Jimbo’s...Naturally!, Mother’s Market & Kitchen, and Lassen’s Natural Foods & Vitamins refuse to sell eggs from hens confined in tiny battery cages. **Yet, Andronico’s continues to support this abusive practice.**

Battery cages prevent birds from engaging in many natural behaviors, including walking.



Caged laying hens are confined so intensively that they can’t even spread their wings.

Not only does Andronico’s continue to support abusive battery cage egg production, the company attempts to cloud the issue by stating it is “committed to the highest standards of animal husbandry.” **Does marketing eggs from hens packed into cages so restrictive they can never spread their wings sound like Andronico’s is supporting the “highest standards” in egg production?**

THE BOTTOM LINE: Is saving a few pennies on an egg worth forcing a bird to live her entire life in a space the size of this sheet of paper? If you don’t think so, urge Andronico’s to stop supporting battery cage cruelty.
