

**33,000 SIGNATURES DEMAND TO BE COUNTED!
WE WILL NOT BE SILENCED! WE WILL NOT BE MOVED!
SEPTEMBER 27, 1966--SEPTEMBER 27, 2006**

On September 27, 1966 Matthew Johnson, an unarmed Black youth, was shot in the back by police. Hundreds of people from the community rose up to protest the occupation of Bayview Hunters Point by National Guard troops and tanks.

Forty years later, this community is still being occupied, this time by the San Francisco Redevelopment Agency and City Hall. City Attorney Dennis Herrera and City Hall invalidated more than 33,000 signatures from the people demanding community control of development, using legal tricks and politics. They want to shoot Bayview Hunters Point in the back again, but we ain't gonna let that happen. We demand that our signatures be counted--**the people have spoken!**
