

Drop the Charges! Stop Police Brutality!

On October, 18, 2006 UC Police racially targetted Alette Kendrick, a well-known student activist, repeatedly kicking her, even after she had been cuffed. In the process, 2 other activists were unjustly detained on false charges. Now, even after her assault, administrators are trying to make an example out of her to silence student voices.

Immediately after the detentions, UC police used pepper-spray and batons without warnin against students protesting the UC Regents' visit. This was the first use of pepper-spray in UCSC's history.
