Pursuant to the court's direction, the hearing was continued to May 29, Plaintiff appeared by counsel Susan E. Barisone; Jonathan Che Gettleman appeared for Defendant Anna Galeen Richardson.

Satisfactory proof having been made and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS ORDERED that during the pendency of this action Defendant Anna Galeen Richardson shall refrain from sleeping, setting up bedding, or camping in violation of Santa Cruz Municipal Code Section 6.36.010 while in downtown Santa Cruz in the area comprised of Pacific Avenue and North Pacific Avenue (and adjoining businesses and parking lots); in Scope Park; in the Town Clock Plaza; on Front Street from Spruce Street to Water Street (and adjoining businesses and parking lots, including the Post Office and the Veterans' Memorial Building); on River Street from Soquel Avenue to Madrone

Street (and adjoining businesses and parking lots); and in San Lorenzo Park and the Front/River Street public parking garage [the area identified in red on the map attached hereto]. As used in this order, the terms "sleeping," "setting up bedding," and "camping" shall have the definition ascribed to them at Santa Cruz Municipal Code Section 6.36.010 which states:

No person shall camp anywhere in the city of Santa Cruz, whether on public or private property, except as hereinafter expressly permitted. "To camp" means to do any of the following:

- Sleeping 11 p.m. to 8:30 a.m. To sleep at any time between the hours of 11 p.m. to 8:30 a.m. in any of the following places:
- Outdoors with or without bedding, tent, hammock or other similar protection or equipment;
- In, on or under any structure not intended for human occupancy, whether with or without bedding, tent, hammock or other similar protection or equipment;
- In, on or under any parked vehicle, including an automobile, bus, truck, camper, trailer or recreational vehicle.
- Setting-up Bedding 11 p.m. to 8:30 a.m. To establish or maintain outdoors or in, on or under any structure not intended for human occupancy, at any time between the hours of 11 p.m. to 8:30 a.m., a temporary or permanent place for sleeping, by setting up any bedding, sleeping bag, blanket, mattress, tent, hammock or other sleeping equipment in such a manner as to be immediately usable for sleeping purposes.
- Setting-up Campsite Anytime. To establish or maintain outdoors or in, on, or under any structure not intended for human occupancy, at any time during the day or night, a temporary or permanent place for cooking or sleeping, by setting up any bedding, sleeping bag, blanket, mattress, tent, hammock or other sleeping equipment or by setting up any cooking equipment, with the intent to remain in that location overnight.
