Former MKO Cadre Says Israel is the only Safe Haven for Rajavi, 27 Jan. 04

Since Israel is the only regime in the region that is consistently hostile to Islam; it may also be the only safe haven for the MKO.

BAGHDAD, Iraq, Jan. 27--A former member of Mujahideen Khalq Organization [MKO] on Tuesday said the only safe haven for MKO at the moment is Israel.

Hossein Forqani, who was speaking to IRNA, added, "Israel is



the only regime in the region which is clearly hostile to the Islamic system and uses every possible opportunity to strike a blow against Iran.

This is while America intends to use the MKO to exert pressure on Iran. By sending the group from Iraq to Israel, it wants to keep Iran worried about the activities of this terrorist organization."

He stressed that in the wake of agreements made between the US, Israel and the MKO, the only safe haven for MKO appears to be Israel.

Several MKO members have reportedly expressed their interest in quitting the group and return to Iran or go to other countries.

Some 3,800 MKO members are currently being held by the coalition forces to be ultimately expelled from Iraq in the near future.

Iran has announced that those MKO members, who have not committed any crime, would be granted amnesty.

In June 2002, MKO leader Massoud Rajavi, convened a secret mass meeting at a conference center belonging to Iraqi Military Intelligence in the Al-Karakh district of Baghdad. Speaking to over 6,000 MKO members, Rajavi warned that a US invasion was inevitable and that the MKO would have three options: voluntarily withdrawing from Iraq, preemptively attacking Iran or assisting the Iraqi regime against invading American forces.
