Come witness Round One in the continuing battle against the corporate-dominated Federal Communications Commission by local grassroots radio station, San Francisco Liberation Radio. This battle was first challenged by the FCC last July 2nd when they came to our studios and asked to enter and "inspect the equipment". Matters were escalated when the FCC, accompanied by US Marshalls, and SF Police Officers raided the small studio of the micro-powered station (located in the basement of a private home) in October of 2003. We had been somewhat expecting this since our two license applications had been turned down even though we were not interfering with anyone and we had been commended by the city government for our history of community service.
