

CALENDAR • SPRING SEMESTER 2005

- JANUARY 17, 2004** **California residency determination date for Spring 2005 Semester.** To be eligible as a California resident for the Spring 2005 school term, a student must have resided in California continuously, with the intent of making California his/her permanent residence, since January 17, 2004.
- JANUARY 18, 2005** **First session of day and evening credit and noncredit classes. First day to add and drop credit classes and to change sections.**
- JANUARY 21, 2005** **Saturday class instruction begins.**
- JANUARY 22, 2005** **Sunday class instruction begins.**
- JANUARY 31, 2005** **Last day to withdraw, drop or reduce course work units in order to obtain an enrollment fee and 100% nonresident and foreign student tuition fee refund.**
Students are liable for all fees for full-term courses dropped after this date.
- FEBRUARY 4, 2005** **LAST DAY TO ADD CREDIT CLASSES IN PERSON.**
- FEBRUARY 5, 2005** **LAST DAY TO ADD CREDIT CLASSES ONLINE USING WEBSTARS.**
- FEBRUARY 11, 2005** **LAST DAY TO DROP CREDIT CLASSES** (no notation will appear on the student's permanent record). If a student withdraws from a class after this date, a "W" will appear on the student's permanent record. No drops will be approved after this deadline. Last day to officially withdraw, reduce course work to qualify for 50% pro-rata nonresident and foreign student tuition fee refund.
- FEBRUARY 17, 2005** Last day for students to fulfill requirements to remove an Incomplete grade received in the previous semester.
- FEBRUARY 18, 2005** **Holiday. Lincoln's Birthday. College closed. No classes held.**
- FEBRUARY 19, 2005** **President's Birthday weekend. College closed. No Saturday classes.**
- FEBRUARY 20, 2005** **President's Birthday weekend. College closed. No Sunday classes.**
- FEBRUARY 21, 2005** **Holiday. Washington's Birthday. College closed. No classes held.**
- FEBRUARY 22, 2005** Last day to request a credit/no credit (CR/NC) grading option where this option is available for all full-term classes.
- MARCH 4, 2005** Last day to petition to receive Associate Degrees or an Award of Achievement or Certificate of Completion.
- MARCH 18, 2005** **END OF MIDTERM PERIOD.**
- MARCH 25, 2005** **Cesar Chavez Day. No classes held.**
- MARCH 26–APRIL 1, 2005** **SPRING VACATION.**
- APRIL 6, 2005** **Midterm grades available on the web at www.ccsf.edu.**
- APRIL 8, 2005** Last day to file a petition for leave of absence. Last day for for student-initiated or instructor-initiated withdrawal. No student-initiated or instructor-initiated withdrawals will be approved after this date. Instructors must assign a grade or an incomplete after this date.
- MAY 20–27, 2005** **FINAL EXAMINATIONS for day, evening and Saturday and Sunday classes.**
- JUNE 8, 2005** **Final grades available on the web at www.ccsf.edu.**
