Students are also being recruited through video games, which track and then contact very young potential recruits, Army interactive vans which visit our campuses and let students play simulated war games, and a plethora of high market value advertising campaigns.....all designed to get students involved in The Military. These recruiting techniques disproportionately target low-income and minority communities.
