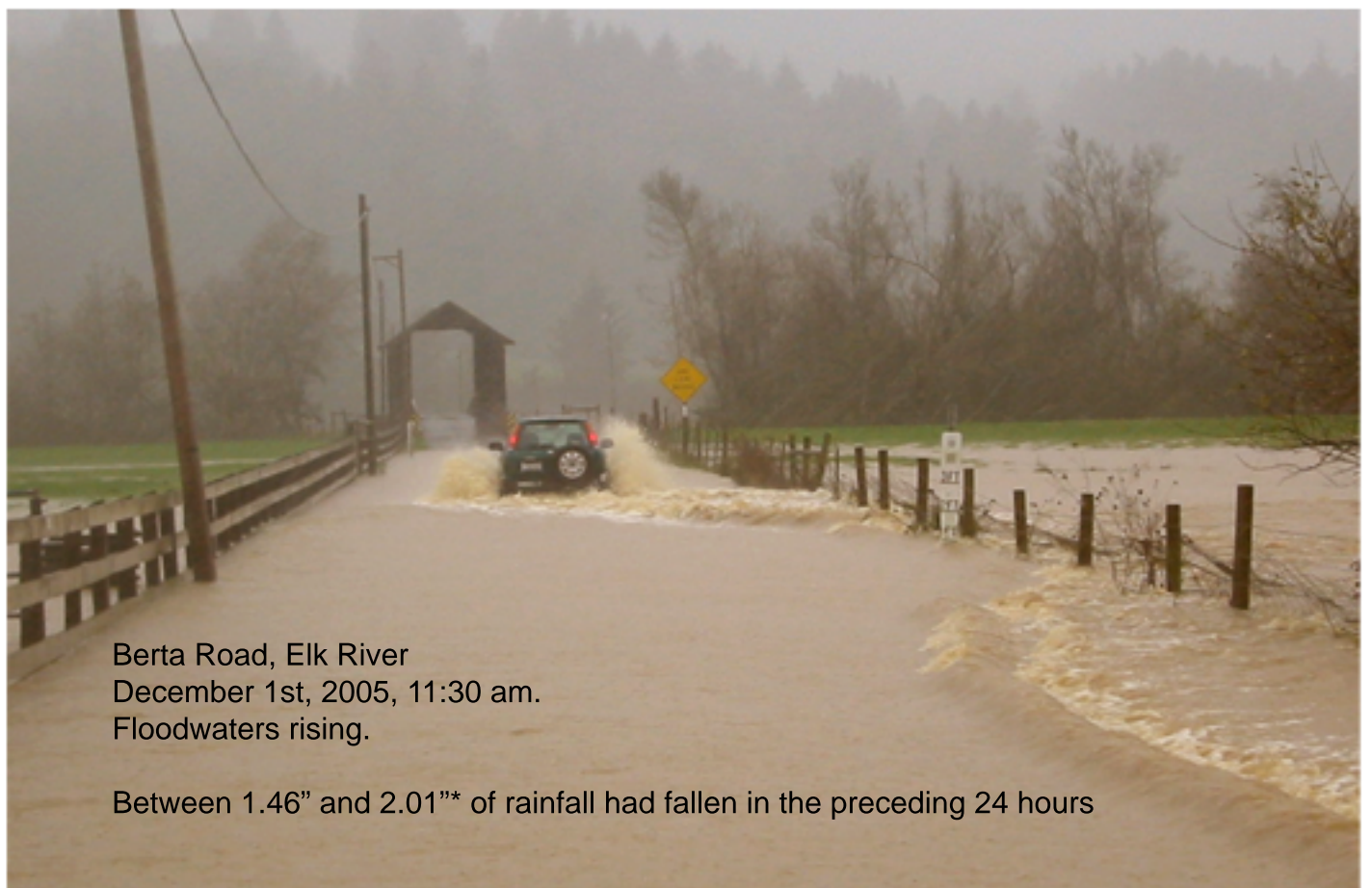


Howard Heights Road, Freshwater
December 1st, 2005, 11:00 am.
Floodwaters rising.

Between 1.46" and 2.01"* of rainfall had fallen in the preceding 24 hours at the time of this picture.
The storm would continue to drop another .20" and .53" over the following 6 hours, for a rainfall total of between 1.46" and 2.53" over a 30 hour period.
By mid-afternoon the floodwater exceeded the level of the 1955 flood, as measured on the abutment of the Bridge.
