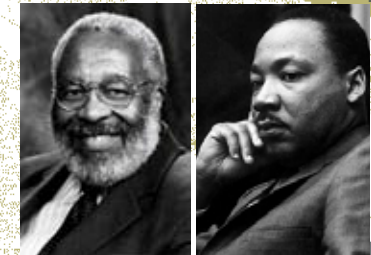

King's *Beyond Vietnam– A Time to Break Silence* is considered to be one of the greatest speeches of the 20th century. Dr. Vincent Harding, an intimate colleague of King who encouraged him to speak out against the war, authored the speech. Harding, a foremost authority on the civil rights movement, will be with us for a deep soul searching exploration of King's question, "Where do we go from here?" How do we, as a people, find our moral compass and how do we point ourselves in the direction of social justice based on spiritual oneness? How do we, individually and collectively, reconcile where we have been with where we want to go as a peaceful, just, and empowering people?
