A physician by training, Dr. Shukla is currently coordinator of the independent public health organisation, SATHI-CEHAT based in Pune. He is a member of the advisory group for community action for the National Rural Health Mission, and member of the core group of NGOs of the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) in India.

Among his many publications, he is author of *The Rights Approach to Health and Health Care*.
