Synopsis: To document correspondence between a Philadelphia, PA resident and Eric McDavid.

Enclosure(s): Enclosed for Philadelphia and the file is a copy of a one-page, handwritten letter, dated 5/6/2006, from [redacted], Philadelphia, PA, to Eric McDavid.

Details: This communication is being directed to Philadelphia to provide information about a possible environmental/animal rights extremist in its territory.

Eric McDavid is currently an inmate at the Sacramento County Main Jail, 651 I Street, Sacramento, California. He, along with [redacted] and [redacted], were arrested on 1/13/2006 and indicted on 1/25/2006 for plotting to destroy with explosives several facilities in the Sacramento Division, including a United States Forest Service (USFS) genetics research facility in Placerville, California. Captioned subjects are anarchists and were planning to commit acts of eco-terrorism on behalf of the Earth Liberation Front (ELF).

The Sacramento County Main Jail provided the enclosed letter on 5/23/2006. The return address on the envelope and letter reads: [redacted], Philadelphia, PA 19139. Although the letter's text references previous correspondence between [redacted] and McDavid, the enclosed is the first such correspondence Sacramento has received. Based on the text of the letter, it is unlikely the author and McDavid are associates. The content appears benign in nature. ACS checks on [redacted] and his address were negative.
