The City of Vallejo and the Greater Vallejo Recreation District are planning to destroy the Glen Cove ancient Native American burial site and shell mound in order to expand a trail and build a parking lot and toilets.

They have so far ignored the concerns of the Native community and their supporters, and time is running short to protect this site.

We are asking all advocates, activists, elders, spiritual leaders, families, the Native community and environmental and social justice activists to join us in this Spiritual ceremony and gathering.

Let's send a clear message that the Glen Cove sacred site must not be destroyed, and that we are joining together to protect his special place.
