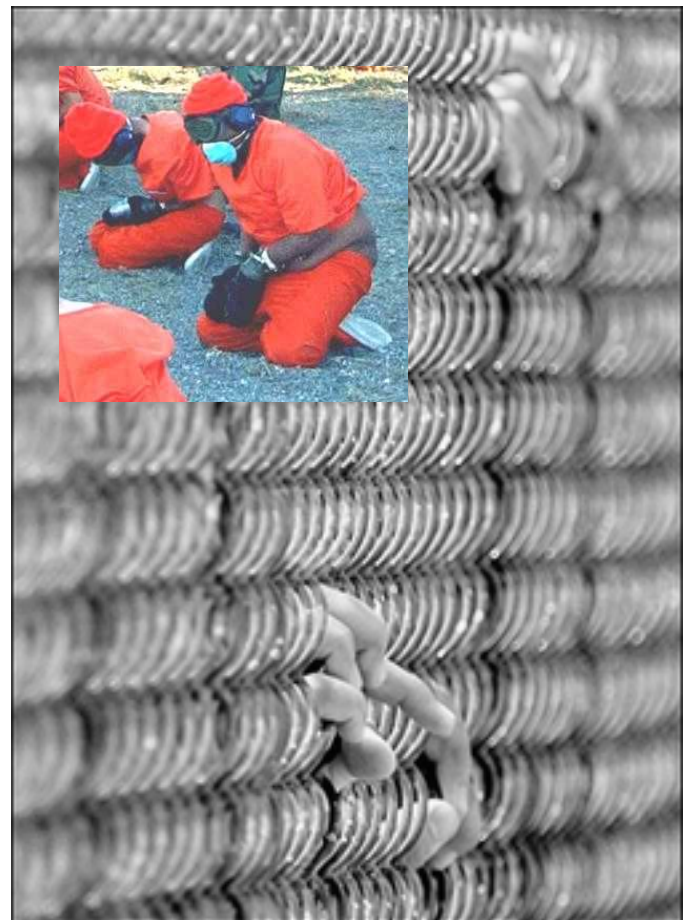
Ms. Cohn will examine current violations of
