

Hands-On Fruit Tree Grafting Workshop

Learn to do your own fruit tree grafting in this workshop with expert California Rare Fruit Grower John Valenzuela. In this hands-on workshop we will graft a new variety onto the EcoHouse's plum tree which was damaged by last winter's storms. You will learn how to graft apple, cherry, pear and more, and be able to create your favorite fruit trees.

Grafting is a horticultural technique whereby tissues from one plant are inserted into those of another so that the two may join together. In the case of an apple tree, this allows you to grow many different varieties of apples on one tree.
