



From Lightbulbs to Legislation:

An Interactive Climate Change Series

February 5 - 18, 2012

In this three-session series of tours and workshops, we'll explore the many layers of climate solutions, from greywater systems and living roofs to policy making and community action.

Session 1: Nuts & Bolts (Sun, Feb 5, 11am-1pm) - Gather with a small group of community members for a primer on climate science and policy. Swap information, resources and solutions for taking action on climate change.

Session 2: EcoHouse Climate Adaptation Tour (Sun, Feb 12, 11am-1pm) - Draw inspiration from do-it-yourself projects such as our living roof; permaculture food forest; ground-breaking constructed wetlands; simple laundry greywater systems; a 1100 gallon rainwater cistern; natural cob and strawbale building; solar panels; and lots more.

Session 3: Field Day (Sat, Feb 18, Time TBA) - Tour SF's recycling center, Recology SF, and its innovative Artist in Residence program. Hear from Bay Area artists who are turning discarded material into stunning art.
