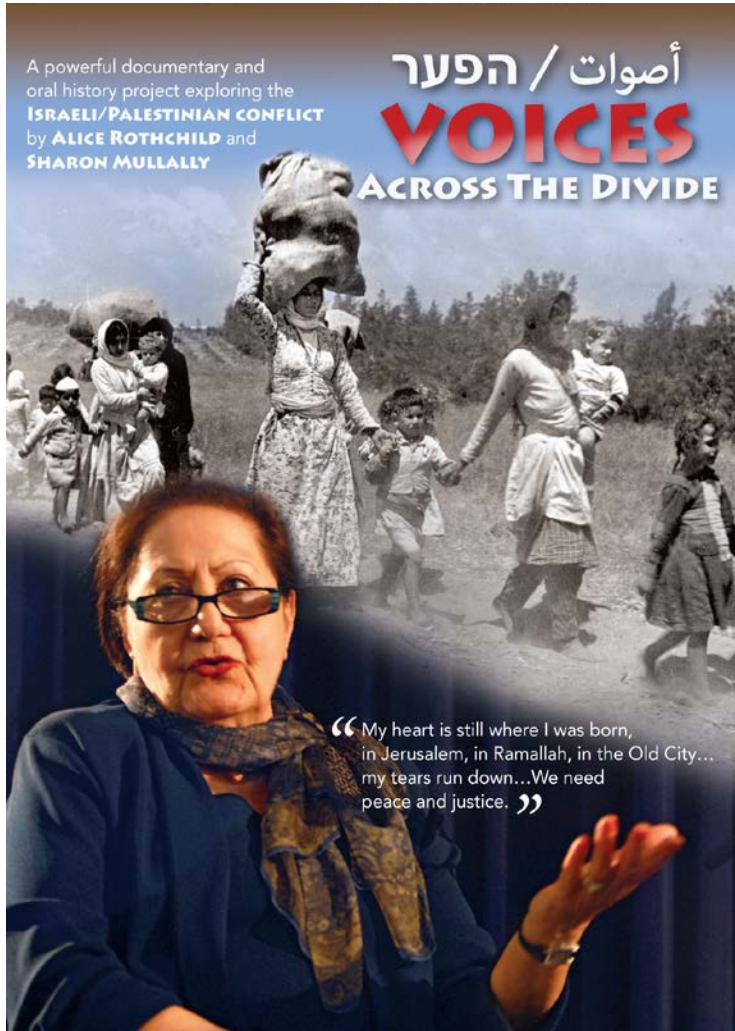


Voices Across the Divide

Voices Across the Divide explores the Israeli/Palestinian conflict through rarely heard personal stories. Narrated by Alice Rothchild, an American Jew raised on the tragedies of the Holocaust and the dream of a Jewish homeland in Israel, the film follows her personal journey as she begins to understand Palestinian perspectives while exploring Palestinian experiences of loss, occupation, statelessness and immigration to the United States. The documentary also explores the implications and contradictions of deeply held cultural beliefs in the Jewish community.
