Caravana43 is a project developed with the purpose of bringing to the United States a group of 16 Ayotzinapa Parents of the 43 Normalista students disappeared on September 26, 2014 in Iguala, Guerrero, Mexico.

The purpose of the Caravanas into the States is to give an international forum to the parents who have lost their children to the systemic violence and impunity committed by the Mexican government and its police. Another goal, just as important is to shed light on the connection between US foreign policy and the socioeconomic conditions and violence in Mexico, since US funding equips and trains Mexican military and police through the Merida Plan just like it did in collaboration with the government of Colombia with similarly disastrous results. We deeply feel there is a very strong connection between the people of our two countries on the issue of the systemic violence from the police against its citizens.
