Good afternoon City Colleagues,

We write again to check in with you on the ongoing activities and behaviors on the City Hall grounds on Tuesday afternoons through Wednesday mornings. This message is particularly intended for those of us who work at the City Hall campus and the Downtown Branch.

It is important that you have shared the impacts of these individuals' behaviors on your daily work as well as the ability and security of our customers to transact business with the city and library. We have heard about the vandalism, the threatening and intimidating behaviors, the profanity and level of noise around our offices that has disrupted meetings, interviews and our work, the garbage, the smoking, drug use and drinking, the human waste, the aggressive behavior toward staff, and how we hear that City Hall is not a welcome place for the public on these days.

As we stated last week, this condition is not acceptable. City Hall is a place for all of the public and the public and city employees need to be able to conduct business in a safe, welcoming and professional environment. Again, we regret that you have been subjected to offensive and disruptive conduct.

We continue to engage in solutions to curtail these impacts on City Hall and will be stepping up our efforts today. As always, if you see illegal activities or feel unsafe, please call 9-1-1 immediately.
