Journalist and historian Elias Castillo, author of "A Cross of Thorns: The Enslavement of California's Indians by the Spanish Missions," speaks on the sufferings of Native Californians in the Spanish missions, and the documentary evidence he has uncovered: that enslavement, forced labor, and physical punishment were the deliberate policy of the founder of the California missions, the newly canonized Saint Junipero Serra.
