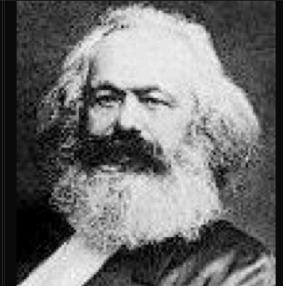

NO NUKES! U.S. Imperialism and the Continuing Threat of Nuclear Annihilation



The threat of nuclear annihilation has receded in the public consciousness, but not in the real world, as U.S. imperialism continues to push against nuclear powers in Ukraine and the South China Sea. In this session, **Eugene Ruyle**, Emeritus Professor of Anthropology at Cal State Long Beach, will review how, for U.S. imperialists, atomic diplomacy began even before the atomic bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki and continues to occupy a central place in U.S. military planning.
