- Have you found a secluded spot to park your current home, but worry you **may find yourself displaced** and/or threatened with seizure of everything in it?
- Would you like to see the City or some non-profit **open a secure RV campground** ?
- Doesn't Santa Cruz have an emergency need for an overnight **dusk-to-dawn carpark**?
- Do you feel **powerless and humiliated when given a move-along order** by a cop, neighbor, or "volunteer" ?

**Fight Back With Solidarity:** Join organizations supporting N.P.O.'s (Non-Property Owners) such as the S.C. Tenants Organization, *HUFF, Conscience and Action*, and the state-wide Union of the Homeless

+++ Use a cell-phone or other recording device to document all questionable interactions.

+++ Report harassment action by rangers, cops, and hostile neighbors.

+++ Know Your Rights & Share suggestions and advice on "smart survival tactics", "diplomatic camping", and learn your legal rights in shared workshops.

+++ Demand that Rangers and Police follow the 72-hour law.

- Are you awakened by **rude pounding, shouting, and banging** in the dead of night?
- Is your family or loved one being **made to feel unwelcome** in a neighborhood in which you've parked for **less than 72 hours**?

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
