BACKGROUND: At the conclusion of Oral Communications portion of the City Council's March 26, 2019 meeting, the following action was taken.

MOTION: Councilmember Mathews moved, seconded by Mayor Watkins, to agendize an item for consideration at the April 9th meeting to consider two issues:

- The disposition and closure plan of the Ross Camp.
- Consider rescinding the Council decision designating Lot 24 as a safe sleeping or camp site, and that this discussion and action occur in open session.
