Co-Founder & CEO of OIGETIT Fake News Filter

Mr. Franklin Urteaga 尤福林

Mr. Urteaga worked for two U.S. Presidents: Bill Clinton & Barack Obama. He served 5 years at the White House during President Clinton's Administration, working for the Deputy Chief to the President, and serving as a member of the prestigious White House Technology Working Group. During his time as a White House Technology Advisor, Franklin worked on producing and supporting national technology programs for the U.S. In 2012, he served a 2nd U.S. President, Barack Obama, by working in his presidential re-election campaign. As a Senior Campaign Aide, Franklin managed 6 major campaign offices, 17 senior staff, and a team of 1,500 campaign workers in Southern Virginia.

Senior Director of the Bay Area Council Economic Institute

Dr. Sean Randolph

Dr. Sean Randolph is Senior Director of the Bay Area Council Economic Institute, where he served as President & CEO from 1998-2015. Dr. Randolph previously served as director of international trade for the State of California (1994-98), where he directed international programs to stimulate exports and introduce California companies to overseas markets. Before service with the state, he was Managing Director of the RSR Pacific Group, an international business consulting firm specializing in Asia and Latin America. His professional career includes extensive experience in the U.S. Government, on the U.S. Congress staff (1976-1980), and White House staff (1980-1981).

Dr. Lai Xu

Dr. Lai Xu is the Vice President of International Applied Technology Institute. She worked in World Bank as senior data scientist and was one of the first Chinese worked for WB. She is a leading scientist in the fields of Data Collection & Analysis, System Engineering, UI, AI, Fintech and Blockchain. She was awarded by World Bank consecutively on subjects of International Comparison Program, Data collecting and sharing, Global Finance Integration, Social Welfare & Resilience and Fairness Indicator, Development of Sustainable Resources & Analysis. Dr. Xu was also nominated as the Chief IT Officer by the White House.



Tsai Wan-Tsai Professor Emeritus in the Wharton School

Dr. Marshall Meyer

Dr. Marshall W. Meyer is the Tsai Wan-Tsai Professor Emeritus in the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania, where he is also a Professor of Management and Sociology Emeritus, an associate member of the Center for East Asian Studies, and a faculty member of the Center for the Study of Contemporary China. Dr. Meyer is also an Adjunct Professor of Management at the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology and a scholar of the Yale Chief Executive Leadership Institute. For nearly two decades, Dr. Meyer has studied the ongoing reforms of Chinese enterprises, including ownership reform, management reform and management innovation in China.

Mr. David Cao

Mr. David Cao is a pioneer and a leader of the venture capital ecosystem in Silicon Valley. He founded Silicon Valley Entrepreneurs & Startups 10 years ago, and now is Silicon Valley's largest entrepreneur community with over 35,000 members. He founded several large developer communities including Silicon Valley Developer Network (SVDN), Silicon Valley Android Developers. He is also serving or served as advisor for DocuSign, Ehouse Capital, Peakview's Fund of Fund. He has led the process of selecting 400 startups out of over 10000 startups and presents them to the F50 global corporate and investor network. He also leads the investment processes for over 30 of the selected startups.
