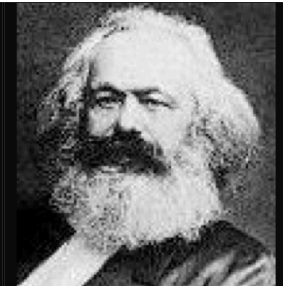

"Fascism: What It Is and How To Fight It" - a two part talk including a historical overview of the events leading up to the rise of fascism in Europe leading up to WWII, and a political analysis of the failures of the communist movement at the time in preventing it. This all in light of the current rise of white supremacy and fascist movements in the U.S., Europe and Latin America and the lack of a united left movement to fight it. Presented by Peoples Alliance members **Bill Bowers** and **Tova Fry** (both former WWP): Bill leading with the historical overview and Tova Fry following with the political analysis, largely based on Trotsky's work of the same name.
