We are especially pleased to present ***“Close Down the Camps”*** with **Bill Ong Hing, JD**, Director of Immigration and Deportation Defense Clinic of the University of San Francisco. Professor Hing recently returned from a visit to the Texas Border Center where he worked as part of a legal team to inspect the Clint facility, and interviewed the children and attendants there, which he will describe. He will also explain legal aspects of these facilities and the current laws affecting immigration practices. USF law students will also participate in this presentation. Dr. Hing’s expertise includes Immigration Law and Policy, Migration Theory, Racism and U.S. Law, Rules of Evidence, Professor of Law and Migration Studies, and founder of the Immigrant Legal Resource Center.
