VIOLENT RACIST IN YOUR AREA

LINDSAY DANAE GRATHWOHL

Your neighbor Lindsay Danae Grathwohl lives at **15830 Via Del Sol**. Lindsay Grathwohl is a prominent figure in Northern California's far-Right activist network and has ties to violent fascist formations including the Proud Boys, American Guard, and the Golden State Skinheads. On social media, Grathwohl expresses hatred for immigrants as well as anti-black racism. Her unhinged and vile posts have resulted in her being permanently banned from using Facebook and Instagram. She has appeared as a guest on Info Wars with Alex Jones, who claims the 2012 Sandy Hook Elementary School shooting was fake, though that claim is demonstrably false. In 2018, Alex Jones gave Grathwohl \$5,000 to fund her activism. Over the past four years, this "activism" has brought Grathwohl to march side-by-side with neo-Nazi groups such as Rise Above Movement, Identity Europa, and Traditionalist Worker Party, many of whom were involved in planning the Charlottesville "Unite the Right" rally in August 2017 that resulted in the death of activist Heather Heyer.

Lindsay constantly invokes her late father Larry David Grathwohl, who infiltrated the Weather Underground for the FBI and also made appearances on Info Wars to discuss the (non-existent) "new world order" with conspiracist wingnut Alex Jones. Following in her father's footsteps, Lindsay Grathwohl peddles old and tired conspiracies that date back to the height of the John Birch Society. Much like the racist arguments against the work of Martin Luther King Jr. and other civil rights activists in the 1960s, Lindsay accuses movements such as Black Lives Matter to be nothing more than "communist" or "Marxist" in an effort to dehumanize and villify protests against police brutality, subsequently provoking violent attacks against protestors in the process. Lindsay has shown support for Kyle Rittenhouse, the 17-year-old who shot and killed two Black Lives Matter protesters in Kenosha, WI earlier this year.

Lindsay frequently travels to Sacramento, CA, Portland, OR, and cities across the Bay Area to participate in violent, targeted demonstrations in support of her fascist counterparts. She has become increasingly involved in recent provocations as a result of her belief in the conspiracy theory that the 2020 presidential election was impacted by widespread voter fraud. She has been present at a number of post-election demonstrations in Sacramento that have erupted in violence and has expressed her readiness to organize and attend more in the near future.

Lindsay Grathwohl is a violent danger. She admitted in a 2018 video on Facebook that, "I've hit phones, I've moved people, pushed people. I have. I'm going to be honest." Grathwohl's social media posts have included explicit threats against local businesses that display support for Black Lives Matter. Lindsay Grathwohl's past violent actions, her connections to dangerous and deranged militia groups, and her ongoing political organizing that tolerates white supremacists and neo-Nazis makes her a threat to the community.
