**ORDER DISSOLVING PRELIMINARY  
INJUNCTION**

On December 30, 2020, Plaintiffs Santa Cruz Homeless Union, Santa Cruz Food Not Bombs, Alicia Avalos, Hannah Hegel, Chris Ingersoll, and Randolph Tolley (collectively, "Plaintiffs") filed an Ex Parte Application for Emergency Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction against Defendants Santa Cruz City Manager Martin Bernal, Director of Parks & Recreation Tony Elliot, Chief of Police for the City of Santa Cruz Andrew Mills, and the City of Santa Cruz ("City") (collectively, "Defendants"). Dkt 1. The Court granted Plaintiffs' temporary restraining order application on December 30, 2020. Dkt. 5. After holding a preliminary injunction hearing on January 6, 2021 (Dkt. 11), the Court granted the motion for preliminary injunction on January 20, 2021. Dkt. 27. On April 1, 2021, the Court modified the preliminary injunction, permitting the City to relocate campers to the Benchlands. Dkt. 49.

Since the Court granted the motion for preliminary injunction, the Court has held several status conferences. Dkts. 42, 47, 59. After the last status conference, the Court ordered the Parties to meet and confer regarding issues raised at the hearing and set this matter for an order to show cause hearing as to why the preliminary injunction should not be dissolved. Dkt. 60. On June 29, 2021, the Court held the order to show cause hearing. For the reasons discussed at the hearing and as summarized below, the Court now **DISSOLVES** the preliminary injunction issued on January
